Resident Survey 2023

We will be running our annual residents survey again in June/July. It is important we align our budget with the priorities of the residents so please do take the time to complete and return the online survey.

The Childrens Playpark and The Chapel

One of the ongoing challenges with our development has been aligning ownership of the various parcels of land. The intent is for Homes England to transfer ownership of the Children's Playpark to the South Oxfordshire District Council and from there to the Parish Council but we are still waiting for a timeline for this to take place. Until this happens, the Parish Council is not in a position to affect any repairs or to replace the missing children's swings.

We are also waiting for an update from Homes England on the future plans for the Chapel. We appreciate this is very frustrating for residents and whilst the CMMC has no direct responsibility for these areas, we do continue to maintain pressure on the relevant parties for the benefit of all residents.





Balancing the Books

CMMC has to balance the budgets. Some projects were held back during Covid and we are now assessing essential large works that need to be done over the coming years, spreading the costs where possible.

A major project under review is the replacement of the embedded wood that is rotting around the parking bays. The challenge is to find an efficient, aesthetically pleasing and affordable way of dealing with this issue.

The CMMC increased the 2022/23 budget by 6%, 4% below Inflation which is impacting planned projects. We have also seen building materials increasing significantly faster than the inflation rate. We are working hard to mitigate the increases in costs as well as working together with First Port to use local businesses for works on Cholsey Meadows.

Landscape Maintenance

The new Nurture zoning programme seems to have been far more successful in maintaining a consistent standard across the development.

Sadly the very hot and dry summer combined with hard frosts has killed a number of plants. Our survey has found over 200 plants need replacing. This will be scheduled from November onwards to increase their chance of survival.

Every 3 years we are legally required to undertake a tree survey. This is planned for July this year. A plan for pruning trees will then be enacted.

Projects under Discussion

The projects currently under discussion are the feasibility of faster fibre optic Broadband this being of great importance since many of us now work from home.

We have had initial meetings with two companies who are progressing with their assessments.

We continue to assess the installation of charging points for electric cars. Again any updates will be reported when the feasibility has been completed.
